Red certainly did not mean "STOP" with a tremendous trade throughout and dare I say it many more could have been sold to vendors advantage. Seasonal show of cows and many more required to fulfil increasing buyer demand. Trade for the time of year is particularly buoyant and lets hope the holiday season does not throw a curve ball into the proceedings.

Top calls rang out to 264p or £1,800.48 for clean, 254p or £1,942.08 for bulls, 226p or £1,720.00 for sucklers and 189p or £1,490.40 for dairy. The overall market average returned at 192p.

55 Dairy - No where near enough for the level of trade and certainly not a vintage show. Trade peaked at 189p (£1,277.64) for a black and white from H. & J. Smith & Sons, Biddulph Moor. JS.&HJ. Gleave, Heywood Lane cow to 186p (£1,246.20), Park House Dairy Ltd, Ashley cows to 184p (£1,490.40), 175p (£1,043.00) etc, T.A. As for the sections, the Friesians continue on absolute fire averaging £121, top call was £160 x 3 from Baddiley Hulse Ltd, Baddiley, Park House Dairy Ltd, Ashley & P.&R. Robinson, Faddiley. Best £130 to £160, mediums £80 to £120.

The native bulls a strong trade but lacking big numbers of quality, but still with nine over £300. Mediums a fast trade with several buyers in operation. Top spot was £405 for an Angus from Mr G.B. Warner, Shrewsbury. Best types £270 to £330, mediums at £180 to £240. Smalls at £60 to £160.

The Continental bulls have been on fire but short on quality to take full advantage, as eighteen sold for over £375. Top price was £495 for a Charolais from J.&AJ. Weatherby, Sandbach. Best at £350 to £420, mediums were on fire at £260 to £310, smalls at £180 to £240.

The native heifers are still in a rich vein of form with the Angus heifers averaging £194, and that average is even more impressive as we've seen more smaller heifers than recent weeks.
