Great to see the numbers increasing especially on a Red, just showing Red doesn't mean stop. In fact on the night it was very much "go" with a fantastic trade prevailing for the time of year. Six buyers in attendance representing 10 different accounts and all keen for the cattle so some real competitive bidding resumed!

Leading lights burnt brightly to top at 279p or £2,187.36 for clean, 243p or £2,240.46 for bulls, 240p or £2,267.44 for sucklers and 224p or £1,505.92 for dairy. Overall market average of 177p just to highlight the level of trade on a Red.

69 Dairy - Flying trade for all weights and grades but the talk of the trade would be young meated cattle racing away to 224p (£1,191.68) for Montbéliards from Martin Partners with further cattle to 176p twice (£1,330.56 & £1,059.52), 174p (£1,252.80) etc. Brown Family saw 181p for their Montbéliard realising a staggering £1,505.92 and further cows to 178p (£1,377.73). Truly amazed where the cattle prices are going especially for the time of year, so lets hope this carries on into the back end!!!
