£1,974 TOP AT COLOURED DAIRY BREED DISPERSAL

The dispersal sale of the red and white herd of pedigree Ayrshires, Dairy Shorthorns and Swedish Reds for Brian Rodenhurst and Family attracted a big crowd of buyers from Wales and the Marches.
