£3,360 TOP FOR ST ASAPH HOLSTEIN FRIESIANS

A top bid of £3,360 with another 20 bids over £3,000 and 149 in all over £2,000 summed up a phenomenal dispersal sale for Huw and Meinir Jones of the entire milking section of their Wigfair herd of registered Holstein Friesians which was held on their farm near St Asaph, Denbighshire.

The top bid of £3,360 was for a newly calved second calver sired by Applejax and off a 13,021kgs dam.

Applejax also sired the top priced calved heifer at £3,255 which had calved last month and was out of a 12,548kgs dam.

There were two at 3,050 guineas, a second calver by Applejax and a third calver also by Applejax.

Dry cows sired by Jeronimo and Applejax carrying their third calves by the British Blue sold to 2,500 guineas.


